

Question 1 (Received 3/13/2018):

Will there be a site-visit scheduled for prospective consultants to scope and evaluate mechanical, logistical and safety conditions at the Rincon Island and Rincon Onshore facilities prior to the submittal of the Statements of Qualifications?

Response 1:

No site visits or job walks will be scheduled before the Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) submittal deadline of April 20th. Having access to the site is unnecessary for developing the materials that the evaluation committee will use to rank each firm because the evaluation process is not based on a project proposal or a bid at this point, rather it is based on the qualifications of the respective engineering firms, their past relevant experience, and a demonstration, through the SOQ, that they are capable of fulfilling the engineering needs outlined in the Solicitation of Interest. At the close of the submission period, the State Lands Commission staff, through the evaluation team, will review and rank the SOQ's.
