California State Lands Commission (CSLC or Commission) is providing notice of proposed changes for incorporation into California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 2, Chapter 31F, which were the subject of written comments from the initial 45 day public comment period that began on June 26, 2015, and closed at 5:00 PM on August 13, 2015.

CSLC will accept written comments regarding these proposed changes for at least 15 days between August 28, 2015 and September 14, 2015. All written comments must be submitted to CSLC no later than 5:00 p.m. on September 14, 2015, and addressed to:
