
21. (Bid for Lease No. 60, P, R.C.) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted instructing the Executive Officer to turn over to the At torney General, for collection, the audited bill in the anount of $\$ 2,660.01$ now owed to the State by the Bishop Company of Orland, California. This amount accrues as a result of the unauthorized taking by the Bishop Company of sand and/or gravel from Sections 9, 22 ana 27 in T. 26 N., R. 16 E., M.D.M., Lassen County. It was brought out during the discussion in connection with this matter that the Bishop Company have repeatediy ignored our requests for settlement of these items.
22. (Trespass of Victor F. Christensen.) The Executive Officer submitted for the consideration of the Commission, the facts regarding the trespass of Mr. Christensen on Section 16, T. 39 N .,
R. 12 E., M.D.M. Steps have been taken without avail, to entex into a lease with Mr. Christensen for his occupancy of this land, Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the Executive Officer was instructed to confer with the Attorney General and report to the Commission at a subsequent meeting as to the proposed course of action.
