

duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted deferring action upon the application of the railroad company to purchase Lot 95, Tract 1206, pending a report of the Executive Officer as to whether this sale would be in the public interest.

32. A letter was read from the State Controller dated September 14, 1944, in which he stated that the sum of \$950,000.00 should be transferred from the State Lands Act Fund to the General Fund, State Beach Fund and State Park Fund in the proportions of 30 percent, 23 $\frac{1}{3}$ percent and 46 $\frac{2}{3}$ percent, respectively. Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted approving this transfer.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
