



5. (Withdrawal of Application to Lease Tide and Submerged Lands near Port Costa, Contra Costa County - Grangers Warehouse, Bank of America National Trust and Savings Association.) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the withdrawal, in accordance with the request of Bank of America National Trust and Savings Association, of their application to lease tide and submerged lands occupied by the Grangers Warehouse near Fort Costa, Contra Costa County.

5. (Permit to Install and Maintain Mooring Buoys, Huntington Beach, Orange County - Orville W. Dant - No. P.R.C. 229) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Acting Executive Officer to issue a permit to Mr. Grville W. Dan't to install and maintain six Navy-type meeting buoys for small fishing eraft and shore boats adjacent to the Huntington Beach Municipal Pier. This permit to expire on December 31, 1943. Inasmuch as no structures are to be constructed, there are to be no charges other than the \$5.00 filing fes.

7. (Application for Right of Way Across Nove River, Mendocino County - Division of Highways - No. F.R.C. 231) The Commission was informed that, pursuant to Section 6210.3 (1st) of the Public Resources Code, the Division of Highways had filed with the Commission an application for a 100 foot right of way across the Nove River in Sec. 18, T. 18 N., R. 17 W., M.D.M., Mendocine County. Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Acting Executive Officer to grant an easement to the Division of Highways for a 100 foot right of way across the Nove River in Sec. 18, T. 38 N., R. 17 W., M.D.M., Mendocine County for the purpose of constructing a high level highway bridge.

8. (Application to Geoupy Tide and Submarged Lands in the Noyo River, Mendecine County - General Petroleum Corporation - No. P.R.C. 234) After being informed that General Petroleum Corporation had made preliminary inquiry for lease of State tide and submarged lands in the Noyo River for the purpose of erecting a bulk petroleum distribution depot, upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the Acting Executive Officer was authorized to enter into negotiations for a lease of the tide and submerged lands involved, and was instructed to present for consideration at the next meeting of the Commission, the terms and conditions of the proposed lease.
