

7. (Application for Permit to Conduct Submarine Seismograph Exploration, Santa Barbara County - The Texas Company - No. P.R.C. 263)

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming the conditional approval heretofore granted to the Texas Company for the conduct of Submarine Seismograph Exploration on tide and submerged lands between the City of Santa Barbara and Gaviota Creek, Santa Barbara County, during the period September 1, 1946 to December 31, 1946, inclusive, for the consideration of the statutory \$5.00 filing fee and subject to the condition agreed to by the Texas Company that said company will indemnify the State and assume any liability arising out of the proposed operations.

8. (Application for occupancy of tide and submerged lands - Guadalupe Canal, San Mateo County - Hotel Brayton - No. P.R.C. 265) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried a resolution was adopted authorizing the Acting Executive Officer to execute and issue a lease to the Hotel Brayton for a sign board location a term of 5 years commencing November 24, 1944, the date of judgment in Case No. 66857 E. N. Fourcans vs. State Lands Commission in Sacramento County Superior Court, the annual rental under this lease to be \$50.00 in accordance with the minimum rental heretofore established for the lease of tide and submerged lands for commercial and industrial purposes.

9. (Application for Right of Way Across Smith's Slough Adjacent to Bair Island near Redwood City, San Mateo County - Bair Island Corporation No. P.R.C. 266) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Acting Executive Officer to execute and issue a right of way easement 275 feet long and 100 feet wide over Smith's Slough to the Bair Island Corporation for construction of bridges for a road and railroad. The consideration for this right of way easement is to be the \$50.00 minimum annual rental heretofore established for the lease of tide and submerged lands for commercial and industrial purposes and the term is to be fifteen years with an option on the part of the grantee to renew for an additional period of ten years at such terms and conditions as may be determined by the State at the time of renewal. The issuance of the right of way easement is to be subject to the condition that the Bair Island Corporation file a corporate surety bond in the amount of \$10,000.00 to guarantee the removal at the termination of the easement of any structures which may have been erected on the demised area.

10. (Resurvey of Tideland Surveys 2, 3 and 9, Contra Costa County) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the approval and filing of the corrected map entitled "Map of Resurvey of Marsh and Tideland Surveys Nos. 2, 3 and 9, Contra Costa County, California", dated August to December 1944, corrected June 7, 1946, as submitted by the Shell Oil Company.
