18. (Acquisition of State Land by Division of Forestry, W. 0. 256)
The Commission was informed that at the March 19, 1948, meeting of the
Commission authorization was given for collaboration with the Division
of Forestry on a program of consolidation of forest school lands through
exchange with the United States in order for Division of Forestry to purchase the consolidated lands. Selection of the United States lands is
proceeding and a report thereon will be made to the Commission as soon as
possible.

Since the selection and report will not be ready before the end of this fiscal year, Division of Forestry at this time desires to enter into a contract with the State Lands Commission for purchase of the lands to be consolidated and thus encumber the \$267,000 available to them this fiscal year.

Upon motion duly made end unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the execution of a contract with Division of Forestry for sale to them of the consolidated lands to be acquired by the State Lands Commission up to a value of \$267,000 subject to subsequent approval by the Commission of the specific lands to be conveyed to Division of Forestry.

19. (Permit for use of State School lands for filming of a Motion Picture by Argosy Pictures Corporation, W. O. 280)

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming the authorization herotofore givento the Argosy Pictures Corporation for use of State School Lands in:

for the purpose of filming a Motion Picture during the period May 3, 1948 to May 19, 1948 for the consideration of statutory \$5.00 filing fee paid.

20. (Request for new Lease, Department of Agriculture formerly P.R.C. 97 - Vidal Junction - Our W. O. 300) The Commission was informed that request has been received from the State Department of Agriculture for a renewal of a lease of State school land in the SW2 of the NW2 of Section 9, T. 1 N., R. 23 E., S.B.M., covering approximately 1 1/4 acros occupied by the Parker Quarantine Station near Vidal Junction, California. This area of school land has been under lease to the Department of Agriculture since it was acquired by the State in 1939. The lease expiring on June 30, 1948 was at an annual rental of \$25.00.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the issuance of a five year lease on 1 1/4 acres in the SWA of NWA of Section 9, T. 1 N., R. 23 E., S.B.M. desired by the State Department of Agriculture at an annual rental of \$25.00. Said lease is to take offect July 1, 1948.
