

35. (Hearings pursuant to Section 126 Government Code, W.O.'s 453, 480, 481, 482, 483, 484, 489, 490, 496, 498 and 516) The Commission was informed that requests have been received for action by the Commission under Section 126 of the Government Code relative to the acquisition by the United States of lands located within the State of California.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Executive Officer to order and conduct the requisite hearings pursuant to Section 126 of the Government Code and under the Rules and Regulations adopted by the Commission on June 14, 1949, on the applications for consent to acquisition by the United States of lands comprising the following sites:

Hearings are to be held at such time as may be determined by the Executive Officer. The proceedings and determinations of all such hearings are to be reported to the Commission for final consideration and action.

36. (Hearings pursuant to Section 126 Government Code) The Commission was informed that in preparing to hold the hearings with respect to Section 126 of the Government Code that were authorized at the Commission meetings of July 11 and July 26, 1949, difficulty had been encountered in that the rules called for payment of costs in advance unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, whereas it was found impossible to do this in conformity with Federal practice. Authority was requested to receive such payment after the hearings are held.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the payment of costs after the hearings are held.

37. (Pacific Gas and Electric Company Matters - Sale of 920 acres of School Land in San Bernardino County, Sac.W.O. 161; Revision of Rio Vista Gas Purchase Contract, Agreement for Easement No. 415, W.O. 465; Granting of Long Term Lease for Contra Costa Steam Plant, W.O. 464) The Commission was informed by Lieutenant Governor Knight that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company had contacted him relative to three matters as follows:

1. Sale of certain school land consisting of 920 acres in San Bernardino County, Sac.W.O. 161;
2. Revision of Rio Vista Gas Purchase Contract, Agreement for Easement No. 415, W.O. 465;
3. Granting of long term lease for the Contra Costa Steam Plant, W.O. 464.
