10. (HALARY ADJUSTMENTS, JELY 1, 1951, EXEMPT POSITIONS - PERSONNEL.) The Commission was informed that at the meeting held July 6 and 7, 1951, the State Personnel Board adjusted salary ranges for nearly all classes of Civil Service employees. This action did not include exempt positions. Increases have been granted to classes immediately below that of Executive Officer, thus affecting internal sclary relationships adversely.

Department of Finance Circular Letter Ho. T51-20, dated July 9, 1951, approved increases for a large number of exempt positions, but deferred action on others, including that of the Executive Officer, State Lands Commission. The circular letter octained the following statement: "Increases for classes for which ranges have not been established nor classification studies undertaken will require in most cases initial action by the appointing power."

OPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESCLUTION WAS ADOPTED APPROVING REVISION OF THE SALARY RATE FOR THE POSITION EXECUTIVE OFFICER, STATE LANDS COMMISSION, FROM \$745 IN THE RANGE (\$613-\$745) AUTHORIZED FEBRUARY 28, 1951, TO \$782, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1951, IN THE RANGE (\$644-\$782). IN ADDITION, THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER, AS APPOINTING POWER, IS AUTSORIZED TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT DOCUMENTS AS MECHESARY TO EFFECT THE REVISION.

11. (REVISION OF RUES AND REGULATIONS OF STATE LANDS COMMISSION - W. C. 278.)
At the meeting of the Commission on February 28, 1961 (Minute Item 16, Pages 1266-1320), proposed revisions of the Ruler and Regulations of the State Lands Commission were presented, and the Executive Officer was authorized to conduct the public hearings prescribed by the Code of Administrative Procedure. At the Commission meeting of April 12, 1961 (Minute Item 19, Pages 1852-1856), the Rules and Regulations submitted on February 28, 1961, were approved by the Commission with certain appoints amendments.

On May 21, 1951, a public hearing was held in Room 115, 217 West First Street, Los Angelos, California, by the Executive Officer, at which each and every one of the Rules and Regulations was presented to those attending, and discussed with them. A hearing was also held in the Business and Professions Building, Sacramento, California, at 9.00 a.m., May 25, 1951, by the Executive Officer.

UPON MOTION DELY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED APPROVING THE POLLOWING AMENOMENTS TO THE REVISED SET OF RULES AND REGREATIONS WHICH WAS APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION ON APRIL 12, 1951.

Section 1900.1; In subsection (f) delete the word "lines" after the word "transmission" and insert "lines for the" after the words "pipe lines".

Insert "and distribution of electricity, telephone lines)," after the word "transmission".

Section 2002, Paragraph (a); Delete "overhead" after the words "pipe lines", the word "lines" after the word "transmission" and "licensee thereof, or" after the words "owner or". Insert "lines for the" after the words "pipe lines," "and distribution of electricity, telephone lines," after the word
