15. (SUBMARIAN) GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION, UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA "
W.O. 1061, P.R.C. 527.) On June 21, 1961 (Nigute Page 1597, Item 17), the
Commission authorized the adoption of a revised form of permit for the
conduct of geophysical exploration operations on tide and submerged lands,
and further authorized the Executive Officer to issue a permit to the Union
Oil Company of California for the conduct of such operations on tide and
submerged lands in Los Angeles and Orange Counties for the period August 1,
1961, to October 81, 1961. A concurrent permit for the proposed operations,
required from the Division of Fish and Same, has not yet been authorized,
and therefore the permittee has requested modification of the effective time
of the Division of State Lands" permit to allow reasonable concurrence with
any permit time specified hereafter by the Division of Fish and Game.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UKANIMOUNLY CARRIED, A MESCLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING REVISION OF THE POINT OF PRINCIP FOR THE COMPUTE OF CHOCKETAL EXPLORATION OPERATIONS ON TIDE AND SUMMERCED LANDS TO BE ISSUED TO THE UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA AS AUTHORIZED ON JUNE 21, 1961, AS FOLLOWS:

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- 1. IN LIEU OF THE SPECIFIC OPERATIES PERIOD OF AUDUST 1, 1961, TO OCTOBER 51, 1961, SUBSTITUTE THE POLLOWING: PRINCISSION IS HEREDY GRANTED TO THE UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA FOR THE CONDECT OF SUBMARINE SELECTION SUBSTITUTE HORSE DURING ANY OPERATING PERIOD OF NOW TO RECEIP MINERY DAYS, CORNECTING NOT BANLIER THAN AUGUST 1, 1961, AND THREE SATING NOT LATER THAN NOVEMBER 30, 1998.
- 2. IN LIGHT OF THE REQUIREMENT IN SECTION (10) OF THE PREMET THAT THE PREMETERS SHALL MADE AN ADVANCE DEPOSIT OF \$600.00 OR NEW FIRST DAY OF EACH MODER OF OPERATIONS UNDER THE PREMETERS, SUBSTITUTE THE POLICY OF \$600.00 OR THE PIRST DAY OF MACE SHALL MAKE AN ADVANCE DEPOSIT OF \$600.00 OR THE PIRST DAY OF MACE THIRTY-DAY PREMICES UNDER THIS PREMIT, AS A MISSIAN DEPOSIT TO DEPRAY THE COSTS OF THE DIVISION OF STATE LANDS THAT ARE INVOLVED IN INSPECTION UNDER THIS PREMIT.

14. (SALE OF VACANT PROBRAL LAND, OBTAINED THROUGH USE OF BASE, SCRIP APPLICATION NO. 10480, LOS ANGELES LAND INSTRUCT, RIVERSIDE COUNTY - CHARLES PERCIVAL HART - S.W.O. 5184.) An offer has been received from Mr. Hart of Los Angeles, California, to purchase Tract 61 (being the SE) of Section 6. T. 7 S., R. 22 E., S.B.M., containing SEG. ST scree in Riverside County. This land may be obtained by the State from the Pederal Government through use of base. The minimum price for scrip for this type of land has been set heretofore at \$5.00 per scree such. Mr. Hart has made an offer of \$1,647.88 at \$5.00 per scree.

The Assessor of Riverside County has assessed contiguous land from \$2.00 to \$6.50 per sore, thus indicating an appraised value of the land applied for of from \$4.00 to \$15.00 per sore. An appealsal by the Countssion's staff indicates that the offer as made is adequate.

The selected land was listed (conveyed) to the State by the United States in List 219, approved June 19, 1951, a certified copy of the Chear List being received in this office July 2, 1951.
