15. (SUBMARIAN GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION, UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA --W.O. 1061, P.R.C. 627.) On June 21, 1951 (Minute Page 1597, Item 17), the Commission authorized the adoption of a revised form of permit for the submorged for authorized the Executive Officer to issue a permit to the Union Oil Company of California for the conduct of such operations on tide and submorged lands in Los Angeles and Orange Counties for the period August 1, 1951, to October 51, 1951. A concurrent permit for the proposed operations, required from the Division of Fish and Gene, has not yet been authorized, and therefore the permittee has requested modification of the effective time of the Division of State Lands) permit to allow reasonable concurrence with any permit time specified hereafter by the Division of Fish and Gene.

UPON MOTION DULT MADE AND UNAMINOURLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING REVISION OF THE POIN OF FRANKS POR NEW CONDUCT OF CROPHYSICAL REFLORATION OPERATIONS ON TIDE AND SUMMERIZED LANDS TO BE ISSUED TO THE UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA AS AUTHORIZED OF JUNE 21, 1961, AS FOLLOWS:

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- 1. IN LINU OF THE SPECIFIC OPERATING PERIOD OF AUDUST 1, 1961, TO OCTOBER 51, 1961, SUBSTITUTE THE POLLOWING, PERMISSION IS DESEDT GRANTED TO THE DETON OIL OCMPANY OF CALIFORNIA FOR THE CONDUCT OF SUBMARINE SEISSDORAPH EXPLOSATION HOLE DURING ANY OPERATING PERIOD OF NOR TO SEDERD MINERTY DATE, CONSERCING NOT EAMLIER THAN AUGUST 1, 1962, AND THEREMATING NOT LATER THAN NOVERDER 30, 1958.
- 2. IN LIGHT OF THE REQUIREMENT IN SECTION (10) OF THE PERMIT THAT THE PERMITTER SHALL MARE AN ADVANCE DEPOSIT OF \$500.00 OF THE FIRST DAY OF EACH MORTH OF OPERATIONS GROUP THE PERMIT, SUBSTITUTE THE FOLLOWING. (10) FOR MACH SELENCE CERES IN OPERATION, THE PERMITTER SHALL MAKE AN ADVANCE DEPOSIT OF \$600.00 OF THE FIRST DAY OF MACH THIRTY-DAY PERIOD OF OPERATIONS UNDER THIS PERMIT, AS A MINIMUM DEPOSIT TO DEPRAT THE COSTS OF THE DIVISION OF STATE LANDS THAT ARE INVOLVED IN INSPECTION UNDER THIS PERMIT.

14. (SALE OF VACANT PEDERAL LAND, OBTAINED THROUGH USE OF BASE, SCRIP APPLICATION NO. 10460, LOS ANOMLES LAND DISTRICT, RIVERSIDE COUNTY - CHARLES PERCIVAL HART - S.W.O. 5164.) An offer has been received from Mr. Hart of Los Angeles, California, to purchase fract 61 (being the SE) of Section 6, T. 7 S., R. 22 E., S.H.M., combaining S28.87 scree in Riverside County. This land may be obtained by the State from the Federal Government through use of base. The minimum price for scrip for this type of land has been set heretofore at \$5.00 per sore cash. Mr. Hart has made an offer of 21, 647.85 af \$5.00 per sore.

The Assessor of Riverside County has assessed contiguous land from \$2.00 to \$5.50 per sore, thus indicating an appraised value of the land applied for of from \$4.00 to \$15.00 per sore. An applaisal by the Counission's staff indicates that the offer as made is adequate.

The selected land was listed (conveyed) to the State by the United States in List El9, approved June 19, 1961, a certified sopy of the Clear List being received in this office July 2, 1961.

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UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF TRACT 61 (BEING THE SALE) OF SECTION 6, T. 7 S., R. 22 E., S.B.M., TO MR. HART AT THE APPRAISED CASH PRICE OF \$1,647.85, SUBJECT TO ALL STATUTORY RESERVATIONS INCLUDING MIMERALS.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.

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
