DUE APRIL 1, 1988, IN THE FORM OF TEN \$1,000.00 BONDS, NOS. R-179017 TO R-179026 INCLUSIVE, DEPOSITED HERETOFORE BY THE PACIFIC LIGHTING CORPORATION IN CONNECTION WITH STATE LEASE P.R.C. 28, SHALL BE RELEASED TO SAID PACIFIC LIGHTING CORPORATION.

No. P.R.C. 594 has issued to him. Zena Mendoga, covering three parcels of tide and submerged lands in Drakes Bay, Marin County. The three parcels each contain a pier which is under lease from Mrs. Mendoga. One sublease to A. Paladini, Inc. is on a year-by-year basis; one to Consolidated Fisheries, Inc. expires December 31, 1951; and one to Joe Balestrieri & Co. expires December 31, 1954. Mrs. Mendoga, as lessee of the State, has requested that the above subleases executed by her and Mr. Mendoga, since decembed, be approved.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO APPROVE THOSE CERTAIN SUBLEASES OF TIDE AND SUBMERCED LANDS DESCRIBED IN LEASE NO. P.R.C. 594 TO MRS. ZEMA MERCOZA, SAID SUBLEASES DEING TO A. PALADINI, INC., CONSOLIDATED FISHERIES, INC., AND JUE BALESTRIERI & CO., SUBJECT TO THE LESSEE RETAINING FULL RESPONSIBILITY UNDER THE LEASE FOR THE EXECUTION OF ALL THEMS AND PROVISIONS THEREOF.

CALIFORNIA, CLRIM, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY - W.O. 1101.) Union Oil Company of California has applied for an emendment to louse P.R.C. 600 held by that company obvering two purcols of tide and submerged lands at Chema. It is desired to extend the existing pier to implude an additional three-dambs, more or less, here of tide and submerged land which has been appraised at \$1,250.00 per sore. The increased area, with an appraised value of \$437.50, calls for an increase in rental of \$26.69 amountly. The next anniversary date of the present lease is April 6, 1952, with fourteen years remaining.

UPON MOTION DULY MAIN AND PHANTMOUNLY CAPE ED. A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO AMEND LEASE P.R.C. SOO, ISSUED TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, BY ADDING O. 3104 ACRE TO PARCEL 2 AS DESCRIBED IN SAID LEASE, AND BY INCREASING THE AMEUAL RENTAL BY THE AMOUNT OF \$28.69, EFFECTIVE APRIL 6, 1982, FOR THE FOURTERN THATS AFTER THAT DATE TO THE DATE OF EXPIRATION ON APRIL 5, 1966.

Prospecting Permit P.R.C. 561 was issued to Mr. David Crowley on November 20, 1950, to permit prespecting for syster and other marine shells in the tide and submarged lands of Corksorew Slough and Deepwater Slough, San Matec County. The permit requires that the permittee shall commence the work of prospecting within air months of the date of issuance. The permittee has now requested an autonation of time for one year within which to commence such operations, and has also requested the issuance of a new permit to previde for an extended date of expiration of the two-year prespecting permit term. The application for extension of time to commence operations is based on the requirement of time involved in preparation of marine equipment for pumping shells, and states that such work is well under way including the caulking of a vessel and the installation of pumping and processing machinery.

Under Section 6891 of the Public Resources Code the Commission may, in its discretion, extend the term of any permit for a period not empeding one year

beyond the original two-year permit term. Such extension could be granted in lieu of the issuance of a new permit in the event that all other existing permit terms had been complied with and commercially valuable deposits of minerals had not been developed by the termination date of the original permit.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO APPROVE AN EXTENSION OF TIME FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM MAY 20, 1951, FOR COMMERCEMENT OF OPERATIONS AS REQUIRED OF SECTION 4 OF PROSPECTING PERMIT P.R.C. 561.

Se. (LEASE TO DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY OF LANDS COMPRISING MOJAVE ANTIAIRCRAFT RANGE - W.O. 1086, P.R.C. 848.) On April 19, 1961, the Commission authorised the Executive Officer to execute the necessary instruments and terminate the easement and right-of-way permit to the United States of America dated Pebruary 18, 1962, for use and occupancy of certain State school lands comprising the Mojave Antiaircraft Bange, otherwise referred to as Comp Irwin. The Notice of Termination was issued so as to make the termination effective on August 9, 1961. Meanwhile negotiations with the Department of the Army have been proceeding, and have resulted in the tender of a lease. The lease is written on a standard Department of the Army form, and contains the following pertinent provisions:

- (a) Annual routal \$1,800.00 (which is at the rate of 6-1/8 cents per acre).
- (b) Period of the lease will be August 10, 1951, to June 80, 1962.
- (c) Prior termination is gracified to the Army for all or part of the area on thirty days! written notice, and to the State on an allowance of an exchange by the Bureau of Land Management.
- (d) The State reserves all minerals.

The rental rate has been fixed by joint appraisal of representatives of the Department of the Army and of this office. It is believed to be an acceptable rate. We feel nor deposits are required.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A BESCLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A LEASE WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY FOR A PERIOD BEGINNING AUGUST 10, 1951, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1962, AT THE RATE OF \$1,300.00 PER YEAR, SAID LANDS BEING DESCRIBED AS FYLLOWS:
