DRAKES BAY, MARIN COUNTY, TO CONSOLIDATED FISHERIES, INC., SAID SUBLEASE BEING FOR A FIVE-YEAR PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1952.

The sublease, approval of which is requested, is a renewal of a sublease previously approved, and will not extend beyond the expiration date of Lease P.R.C. 594.

6. (APPLICATION FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT, SAN FRANCISCO BAY, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF SAN FRANCISCO BAY TOLL CROSSINGS, CONTRA COSTA AND MARIN COUNTIES - W.O. 1092, P.R.C. 703,) The Division of San Francisco Bay Toll Crossings of the Department of Public Works has applied for a rightof-way easement 1000 fost in width and approximately 20,000 feet in length, extending from Pt. San Quentin in Marin County to the southerly part of Castro Point in Contra Costa County. The easement is desired as a necessary preliminary to start of construction of the proposed Richmond-San Rafuel Bridge.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED. A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO SIGN DRAWINGS SHOWING THE RIGHT OF WAY OF THE PROPOSED RIGHOND-SAN RAPARL BRIDGE CROSSING SAN FRANCISCO BAY FROM PT. SAN QUENTIN IN MARIN COUNTY TO THE SOUTHERLY PART OF CASTRO POINT IN CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, SAID RIGHT OF WAY TO BE SHOWN ON THE DRAWINGS AS BEING 10CO FERT IN WIDTH AND APPROXIMATELY 20,000 FEET IN LENGTH, SIGNING THE DRAW-INGS TO INDICATE APPROVAL BY THE COMMISSION, FURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 101.5 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHMAYS CODE.

7. (APPLICATION FOR MINOR STRUCTURE PERMIT, D. B. NELSON, PIPER SLOUGH, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY - W.O. 1075, P.R.C. 704.)

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO D. B. NELSON A MIGOR STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$15 PERMIT FEE, THE AREA TO BE OCCUPIED BEING IN PIPER SLOUGH ADJACENT TO LOT 30, IRVIN AND BLOOMFIELD SUBDIVISION, BETHEL ISLAND, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY.

Application was received from Mr. Nelson prior to January 1, 1952. Filing fee has been paid.

5. (APPLICATION TO DREDGE, CARQUINEZ SIRAITS, CALIFORNIA AND HAWAIIAN SUGAR REFINING CORPORATION, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY - W.O. 1203, P.R.C. 705.) The California and Hawaiian Sugar Refining Corporation has applied to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for an Army permit to dredge an estimated 400 cubic yards of material from Carquines Straits adjacent to those tide and submerged lands now under lease to that corporation. The proposed dredging is for the improvement of navigation, the dredged material to be deposited in Carquinez Straits at depths of 50 feet or more below mean lower low water.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESCLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO THE CALIFORNIA AND HANAILAN SUGAR REFINING CORPORATION A PERMIT TO DREDGE AN ESTIMATED 400 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM CARQUINEZ STRAITS FOR THE INFROVEMENT OF NAVIGATION, ADJACENT TO THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS NOW UNDER LEASE TO THAT CORPORATION, UPON RECEIPT OF AN APPLICATION FOR SUCH PERMIT AND UPON RECEIPT OF THE STATUTORY \$5 FILING FEE.

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
