

STANDARD B & P "NOTES"

23. (APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT, LOS ANGELES COUNTY, WESTERN GULF OIL COMPANY - P.R.C. 821.1(C).) The Western Gulf Oil Company has made application for extension of the term of Submarine Geophysical Exploration Permit P.R.C. 821.1(C), authorized for operations offshore in Los Angeles County. Permit P.R.C. 821.1(C) was issued for the period November 1, 1953, to January 31, 1954, inclusive. The time extension requested is for the period February 1, 1954, to May 1, 1954, inclusive, for the offshore area between the northerly line of Los Angeles County and Point Dume, Los Angeles County. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles was informed that this extension was to be considered. X

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, IT WAS RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

The Executive Officer is authorized to issue an extension of Submarine Geophysical Exploration Permit P.R.C. 821.1(C), in conformance with all operating conditions established by the Commission, to the Western Gulf Oil Company for the conduct of submarine geophysical exploration operations on those tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission lying offshore between the northerly line of Los Angeles County and Point Dume, Los Angeles County, for the period February 1, 1954, to May 1, 1954, inclusive. All other terms and conditions of the exploration permit are to remain unchanged, and the extension is to be effective only as long as a concurrent permit by the Fish and Game Commission is in effect for the same operating area.

24. (APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT, LOS ANGELES, ORANGE AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES, WESTERN GULF OIL COMPANY - P.R.C. 852.1.) The Western Gulf Oil Company has made application for extension of the term of Submarine Geophysical Exploration Permit P.R.C. 852.1, authorized for operation offshore in Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego Counties to permit completion of the exploration program which is in progress currently. Permit P.R.C. 852.1 was issued for the period November 1, 1953, to January 31, 1954, inclusive. The time extension requested is for the period February 1, 1954, to May 1, 1954, inclusive. The Boards of Supervisors of the Counties of Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego were informed that this extension was to be considered. X

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, IT WAS RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

The Executive Officer is authorized to issue an extension of Submarine Geophysical Exploration Permit P.R.C. 852.1, in conformance with all operating conditions established by the Commission, to the Western Gulf Oil Company for the conduct of submarine geophysical exploration operations on those tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission lying between Point Dume, Los Angeles County, and the projection seaward of the California-Mexico Border, for the period February 1, 1954, to May 1, 1954, inclusive. All other terms and conditions of the permit are to remain unchanged and the extension is to be effective only as long as concurrent permit by the Fish and Game Commission is in effect for the same operating area.

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
