15. (PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE LANDS COM-MISSION - W. C. 1855.) The following report was presented to the Commission:

"At the meeting of the State Lands Commission on November 30, 1955, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO INITIATE PROCEDURES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 11420-11427 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE PROVISIONS OF CH. 1724, STATS. OF 1955, PERTAINING TO OIL AND GAS DEVELOPMENT. THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS FURTHER AUTHORIZED TO CONDUCT, IN SO FAR AS CONSISTENT WITH LAW, THE REQUISITE HEARINGS, AND HE IS DIRECTED TO REPORT HIS CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS OF BULES AND REGULATIONS TO THE COMMISSION AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE.

"The office of the Attorney General has made suggestions as to procedure which indicate a revision of the action previously taken."

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, IT WAS RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

THE ACTION TAKEN ON NOVEMBER 30, 1955, RELATING TO THE AMENDMENT OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION (Minute Item No. 8, pages 2503-2504) TE RESCINDED AND THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO INITIATE PROCEDURES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 11420-11427 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION.

16. (REVISION OF COMMISSION LEASING FORICIES - W. O. 1087, W. O. 1124.) The following report was presented to the Commission:

"On October 10, 1955 it was recommended to the Commission that a schedule of rental rates be adopted for resort-recreational piers and commercial structures. The schedule of rentals so recommended was approved as follows:
