Mr. Walhfred Jacobson, City Attorney of Long Beach, was present and indicated that he was in agreement with the report as presented and with the recommendation made by the staff.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, IT WAS RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION APPROVES THE COSTS PROPOSED TO BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, INCLUDING SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK, UNDER PROJECTS, LONG BEACH W. . 16. (CONSIDERATION OF SUBSIDENCE COSTS - W. O. 10,017.) The following report was presented to the Commission:

"On August 15, 1956 (Minute Item 5, pages 2761-2762) the Commission approved the costs proposed to be expended by the City of long Beach, including subsidence remedial work during August, 1956 and engineering surveys, property acquisition and other applicable costs during September, 1956.

"The same elements of subsidence cost expenditures which have become due during September, 1956, which are to be paid in October, 1956, and the amounts which will become due during October, 1956, and are to be paid in October, 1956, accountable under subsidence costs not included in the projects approved by the Commission heretofore (Minute Item 4, pages 2759-60), will require approval by the Commission if credit is to be received by the City of Long Beach for such costs under the provisions of Section 5(a), Chapter 29, Statutes of 1956, lst E.S. The staff of the State Lands Division has reviewed the statements presented by the City of Long Beach with respect to such proposed expenditures during October, 1956 for costs incurred during the months of September and October, 1956. These amounts are tabulated on Exhibit 'A' attached hereto."

THE COMMISSION APPROVES THE COSTS PROPOSED TO BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, INCLUDING THE SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK, AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 'A' HEREOF; SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION, HOWEVER, THAT THE AMOUNT, IF ANY, OF EACH OF THE ITEMS TO BE ALLOWED ULTIMATELY AS SUBSIDENCE COST DEDUCTIBLE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 5(a) OF CHAPTER 29, STATUTES OF 1956, 1ST E.S., WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION UPON AN ENGINEERING REVIEW AND FINAL AUDIT SUBSEQUENT TO THE TIME WHEN THE WORK UNDER ANY OF THESE ITEMS IS COMPLETED; THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER, OR THE ASSISTANT EXECUTIVE OFFICER, OR THE MINERAL RESCUROES ENGINEER ARE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS REFLECTING THE COMMISSION'S CONDITIONAL APPROVAL.
