## LEGISLATION

## (1957 SESSION PROPOSED LEGISLATION - W. O. 2115.11.)

Because of the repeal by plebiscite on November 2, 1954, of the so-called Torrens Land Title Registration Act, and the subsequent passage of Chapter 55 and of Chapter 332 of the Statutes of 1955, registration of lands that had been insured under the Torrens Act was incorporated in and became a part of the records of the Office of the County Recorder of the county involved.

Under the Torrens Land Title Registration Law or Torrens Act, and pursuant to Section 6211 of the Public Resources Code, the State Lands Commission had the duty of once in two years inspecting and investigating conditions in the various counties with respect to land titles, and reporting thereon to the Governor and to the Legislature. With the repeal of the Torrens Act, this duty is now unnecessary.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE STAFF, ON ITS BEHALF, TO HAVE INTRODUCED INTO THE LEGISLATURE A BILL TO REPEAL SECTION 6211 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE.
