(HUNTINGTON BEACH CITY PIER - GEO. -ORANGE COUNTY.)

At its meeting on November 15, 1956 (Item 3, Minute page 2925), the Commission deferred consideration of the report with respect to the controversy between the State and the City of Huntington Beach regarding the failure of Huntington Beach to obtain a State permit for occupancy of State land with its municipal pier. The Commission instructed the staff to bring the matter up at the December meeting, and to invite the City officials to present their position to the Commission at that time.

Staff discussions, at which the Attorney General's office was also represented, have been held with the officials of the City of Huntington Beach on this matter. It was concluded that, pending further discussions between the staff and the officials of the City of Huntington Beach, the matter would not be presented at this time to the Commission for consideration.

IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION DEFER ANY CONSIDERATION OF THE HUNTINGTON BEACH CITY PIER PROBLEM FOR THE PRESENT.
