7. (SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT, SANTA BARBARA TO ORANGE COUNTIES, STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - W. O. 2485, P.R.C. 1852.1.)

After presentation of Calendar Item No. 20 attached, the staff reported to the Commission that it had been informed by the Mayor of the City of Santa Barbara that that City has no objections to issuance of the permit, and that a similar report was received from the District Attorney of Santa Barbara County. The other counties involved - Orange, Ventura, and Los Angeles - did not reply to the notice that was sent to them, but heretofore, under the most recent similar types of transactions, no objections were filed by those counties.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A PERMIT, CONFORMING TO ALL OPERATING CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION, TO THE STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA FOR THE CONDUCT OF GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION OPERATIONS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM PT. CONCEPTION, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE EXTENSION SEAWARD OF THE NORTHERLY CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY, FOR A 90-DAY PERIOD COMMENCING JANUARY 14, 1957. THE PERMITTEE IS TO REIMEURSE THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION FOR ALL OF ITS INSPECTION COSTS. THE PERMIT IS TO BE REFECTIVE ONLY AS LONG AS A CONCURRENT PERMIT BY THE FISH AND GAME COMMISSION IS IN EFFECT FOR THE SAME OPERATING AREA.

(SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT, SANTA BARBARA TO ORANGE COUNTIES, STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - W. O. 2485.)

Standard Oil Company of California has made application for authorization to conduct submarine geophysical explorations on those tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission lying between a line drawn due West from Pt. Conception, Santa Barbara County, and the extension seaward of the northerly corporate limits of the City of Newport Beach, Orange County. A permit has been requested for a 90-day period commencing January 14, 1957. The Boards of Supervisors of the Counties of Santa Barbara, Ventura, Los Angeles and Orange and the Mayor and City Council of the City of Santa Barbara have been informed that this application is to be considered.

The statutory application filing fee has been paid by the applicant.
