After presentation of Calendar Item 13 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A MINERAL EXTIRACTION LEASE TO THE COLUMBIA-SOUTHERN CHEMICAL CORPORATION, THE HIGHEST QUALIFIED BIDDER, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF DIVISION 6 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE, ON 84.01 ACRES OF SOVEREIGN LANDS IN OWENS LAKE, INYO COUNTY, MORE PARTICULARIY DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND HEFEBY MADE A PART HEREOT', AT A ROYALITY RATE ON ALL MINERALS OR MINERAL PRODUCTS EXTRACTED FROM THE LEASED PREMISES AND SOLD IN THE SUM OF FIFTY CENTS PER TON OR 湭 OF THE WEIGHIED AVERAGE SALES PRICE PER TON F.O.B. THE EXTRACTION PLANT, OF TKE AGGREGAIE OF ALL MINERALS AND MINERAL PRODUCTS EXTRACTED FROM THE LEASED PREMISES ANI SOLD, WHICHEVER IS THE GREATER.

(PROPOSED MINERAL EXTRACTION LEASE, SOVEREIGN LANDS, OWENYS LAKE, INYO COUNTY W. 0. 2748.)

On January 27, 1958 one bid was received in response to a published notice of intention of the State Lands Commission to enter into a lease for mineral extraction and as a right of way on in area, 100 feet wide and 37,230 feet long, a total of 84.01 acres of land in Sections 3 and $4, T, 18$ S., R. 37 E., and Section 33, T. 17 S., R. 37 E., M.D.B.\& M., Inyo County.

Minerals will be extracted from brine produced by wells arilled along the right of way and into the bed of Oweas Lake.

Publication of this offer was autiorized by the Commssion on November 12, 1957 (Minute Item 9, page 3601). The bidder, Columbia-Southern Chemical Corporation, offered a minimum royalty of fifty cents per ton or $2 \%$ of the weighted average sales price per ton f.O.b. the extraction plant of all mineral products extracted from the leased premises and sold, whichever is the greater.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE A MINERAL EXTRAGTION IEASE TO THE COLUMBIA-SOUTHERN CEEMICAL CORPORATION, THE HLGHEST QUALIFIED BIUDER, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF DIVISION 6 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE, ON 84.01 ACRES OF SOVEREIGN LANDS IN OWENS LAKE, INYO COUNIY, MORE PARIICUTARLY DESCRIBED IN EXT XBIT "A" AITIACHED AND HEREBY made a part hereof, at a royaity rait on ali minerais os mineral products GXTRACTED FROM THE IEASED PREMISES AND SOID IN THE SUM OF FIFM. Parcel No. 4. Beginning at Sta. 70-12+035 of P.R.C. No. 210, which point is S $33^{\circ} 07^{\prime} \mathrm{E}$ a distance of 6035 feet from Sta. $63-70$ of P.R.C. 210, and is located in Sec. 4, T. 18 S., R. 37 E., M.D.M.

Thence $N 56^{\circ} 53^{\prime}$ E, 500 feet to a point on the center line of Parcel. No. 3 described above.

Parcel No. 5. Beginning at Sta. 70-124035 of P.R.C. No. 210.
Thence $s 56^{\circ} 33^{\prime} \mathrm{W}, 1000$ feet to a point on the center line of Parcel No. 3 described ahove.

Parcel No. 6. Beginning at a point which is $556^{\circ} 53^{\prime} \mathrm{W}$ a distance of 500 feet from Sta. $70-20+145$ of P.R.C. No, 210 (further deseribed in Parcel No. 3 above).

Thence $N 33^{\circ} 07^{\prime} \mathrm{W}, 4110$ feet to a point which is on the center line of Parcel No. 5 above and is $S 56^{\circ} 53^{\prime} \mathrm{W}$ a distance of 500 feet from Sta. 70-124035 of P.R.C. No. 210. Thence continuing N $33^{\circ} 07^{\prime} \mathrm{W}, 1250$ feet.

The total length of the above described center lines is 37,230 feet. The total area of the lands defined by these center lines, excluding the lands already covered by existing leases, is 84.01 acres more or less.
