U.S. vs. Anchor Oil Corporation, et al.
U.S.D.C., Southern District, Los Angeles County (Long Beach Subsidence Matter)

> The U.S.D.C. has stated that the plaintiff's complaint would be dismissed unless an amended complaint is filed by December 10, 1958, together with a new motion for preliminary injunction. If such an amended complaint is filed, the defendants may thereafter file new motions to dismiss and accompanying points and authorities no later than December 24, 1958. The United States may file points and authorities in opposition to any such motions to dismiss by January 9, 1959. Any motions to dismiss will be heard January 15, 1959. In addition, the Court continued the hearing on the Preliminary Injunction to March 23, 1959, but defendants points and authorities in opposition to the motion for preliminary injunction must be filed by March 2, 1959. The State's answer is due not later than March 31, 1959.
