MINUTE ITEM

25. (CONSIDERATION OF SUBSIDENCE COSTS PROJECT, LONG BEACH - ADDITIONAL COSTS TO L.B.W.O. 10,071.)

After presentation of Calendar Item 12 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION CONDITIONALLY APPROVES THE TOWN LOT AREA PROJECT AS A SUBSID-ENCE PROJECT AND THE COSTS PROPOSED TO BE EXPENDED THEREUNDER FOR PROPERTY PURCHASE AND FOR UTILITY RELOCATION, FOR THE PERIOD DECEMBER 11, 1958 TO JUNE 30, 1959, AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND HEREBY MADE A PART HEREOF, SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION, HOWEVER, THAT THE AMOUNT, IF ANY, OF SUCH COSTS TO BE ALLOWED ULTIMATELY AS SUBSIDENCE COSTS DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 5(a) OF CHAPTER 29, STATUTES OF 1956, IST E.S., WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION UPON AN ENGINEERING REVIEW AND FIN. L AUDIT SUBSEQUENT TO THE TIME WHEN THE ITEMS OF WORK HAVE BEEN COMPLETED; AND THAT THE WORK CONFORM IN ESSENTIAL DETAILS TO THE PLANS AND BACKGROUND MATERIAL AS HERETOFORE SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSION; PROVIDED THAT NO ESTIMATE SHALL BE PRESENTLY MADE OF THE AMOUNT OF SUBSIDENCE DEDUCTION ULTIMATELY TO BE ALLOWED BY VIRTUE OF SAID ACQUISI-TIONS AND SAID WORK: FURTHER, THE CITY OF LONG BEACH IS NOT AUTHORIZED TO WITHHOLD FROM REVENUES DUE THE STATE ANY PORTIONS OF THE COSTS OF THE TOWN LOT PROJECT UNTIL COMMISSION APPROYAL HAS BEEN HAD; FINALLY, THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR THE AGSISTANT EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR THE MINERAL RESOURCES ENGINEER ARE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS REFLECTING THE COMMISSION'S CONDITIONAL APPROVAL.

(CONSIDERATION OF SUBSIDENCE COSTS PROJECT, LONG BEACH - ADDITIONAL COSTS TO L.B.W.O. 10,071.)

On June 11, 1958 (Minute Item 22, pages 4120-25) the Commission conditionally approved the costs to be expended in the 1958-59 Fiscal Year by the Harbor Department of the City of Long Beach including subsidence remedial work for the "Town Lot" area-project. Subsequent to the above-mentioned approval, it developed that additional unforeseen expenditures will be incurred by the Harbor Department. These costs will arise from increases in the cost of the purchase of previously approved plats of ground and from the necessity of abandonment and relocation of existing utility lines which will be covered by approximately twenty feet of earth fill.

Revisions are being made by the Harbor Department to the material submitted on May 6, 1958 to the staff for review of subsidence elements in the Town Lot project. Pending staff receipt of, and review of, the revised background material and agreement with the City on the degree of subsidence in the project, it is desirable that the present status continue.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION CONDITIONALLY APPROVE THE TOWN LOT AREA PROJECT AS A SUBSIDENCE PROJECT AND THE COSTS PROPOSED TO BE EXPENDED THERE-UNDER FOR PROPERTY PURCHASE AND FOR UTILITY RELOCATION, FOR THE PERIOD DECEMBUR 11, 1958 TO JUNE 30, 1959, AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND HEREBY MADE A PART HEREOF, SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION, HOWEVER, THAT THE AMOUNT, IF ANY, OF SUCH COSTS TO BE ALLOWED ULTIMATELY AS SUBSIDENCE COSTS DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 5(a) OF CHAPTER 29, STATUTES OF 1956, 1ST E.S., WILL BE DETER-MINED BY THE COMMISSION UPON AN ENGINEERING REVIEW AND FINAL AUDIT SUBSEQUENT TO THE TIME WHEN THE ITEMS OF WORK HAVE BEEN COMPLETED; AND THAT THE WORK CONFORM IN ESSENTIAL DETAILS TO THE PLANS AND BACKGROUND MATERIAL AS HERETOFORE SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSION; PROV DED THAT NO ESTIMATE SHALL BE PRESENTLY MADE OF THE AMOUNT OF SUBSTDENCE DEDUCTION ULTIMATELY TO BE ALLOWED BY VIRTUE OF SAID ACQUISITIONS AND SAID WORK; FURTHER, THE CITY OF LONG BEACH IS NOT AUTHORIZED TO WITHHOLD FROM REVENUES DUE THE STATE ANY PORTIONS OF THE COSTS OF THE TOWN LOT PROJECT UNTIL COMMISSION APPROVAL HAS BEEN HAD; FINALLY, THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR THE ASSISTANT EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR THE MINERAL RESOURCES ENGINEER BE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS REFLECTING THE COMMISSION'S CONDITIONAL APPROVAL.
