(CONSIDERATION OF SUBSIDENCE COSTS PROJECTS, LONG BEACH - ADDITIONAL COSTS TO L.B.W.O. 10,072.)

On June 11, 1958 (Minute Item 21, pages 4107-18), the Cormission approved the costs to be expended in the 1958-59 Fiscal Year by the Harbor Department of the City of Long Beach, including subsidence remedial worls, for the "Subsidence Studies" project. Subsequent to the above-mentioned approval, it developed that additional costs will be incurred by the Harbor Department. These costs will arise from the institution of a sub-project "Lateral Ground Surrace Motion Study" to be implemented by aerial and geodetic surveys combined with precision land surveys; and from the increase in cost of vertical measurements due to a change from 3 rod order to lst order precision.

This project has received initial staff review and is considered to include some "subsidence costs" as defined in Section $1(f)$ of Chapter 29, Statutes of 1956, ist E.S., but not necessarily all of those coṣts as estimated by the City of Long Beach.
