

MINUTE ITEM

18. SERVICE AGREEMENT, CHAPTER 1336/59, CITY OF RICHMOND, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY - W.O. 3261, P. & C.

After consideration of Calendar Item 4 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, ON BEHALF OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AS CONTRACTOR, PROVIDING FOR SURVEYING SERVICES TO BE RENDERED THE CITY PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 1336/59, THE PAYMENT TO THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION FOR SAID SERVICES TO BE THE COMMISSION'S ACTUAL COSTS NOT TO EXCEED \$7500.

SERVICE AGREEMENT, CHAPTER 1336/59, CITY OF RICHMOND, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY - W.O. 3261.

Section 6359 of the Public Resources Code provides that the State Lands Commission shall survey, monument, and record a plat of all tide and submerged lands within two years of any grant by the Legislature.

Chapter 1336/59 conveys certain tide and submerged lands to the City of Richmond, and also requires that the State Lands Commission survey, monument, and record a plat of the granted lands.

This work is to be performed on a contract basis. An agreement for this purpose has been drawn by the City. The agreement provides for rendering survey services at a cost not in excess of \$7500, as estimated by the State Lands Division.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, ON BEHALF OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AS CONTRACTOR, PROVIDING FOR SURVEYING SERVICES TO BE RENDERED THE CITY PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 1336/59, THE PAYMENT TO THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION FOR SAID SERVICES TO BE THE COMMISSION'S ACTUAL COSTS NOT TO EXCEED \$7500.
