

MINUTE ITEM

6. APPLICATION FOR BRIDGE RIGHT-OF-WAY ACROSS SUBMERGED LANDS OF SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, NEAR HILLS FERRY, STANISLAUS AND MERCED COUNTIES, STANISLAUS COUNTY - W.O. 3507, P.R.C. 2563.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 2 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO GRANT TO STANISLAUS AND MERCED COUNTIES A 49-YEAR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR AN AREA 200 FEET IN WIDTH ACROSS THE SUBMERGED LANDS OF THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SITUATE IN STANISLAUS AND MERCED COUNTIES, FOR A BRIDGE RIGHT-OF-WAY. THE AREA IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A STRIP OF LAND 200 FEET WIDE, SITUATE IN TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 9 EAST, M.D.B. & M. THE CENTERLINE OF SAID STRIP IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING AT AN ANGLE POINT IN THE CENTERLINE OF THE NEWMAN-HILLS FERRY ROAD KNOWN AS STATION 139+00, AS REFERRED TO IN BOOK OF HIGHWAY LAYOUTS IN VOLUME G11 AT PAGES 32 THROUGH 36, STANISLAUS COUNTY SURVEYORS RECORDS; THENCE NORTH $41^{\circ} 57' 15''$ EAST ALONG THE CENTERLINE OF SAID ROAD A DISTANCE OF 439.32 FEET; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY (THROUGH AN ANGLE OF $24^{\circ} 00'$) ALONG A TANGENT CURVE CONCAVE TO THE NORTHWEST HAVING A RADIUS OF 2,000 FEET AN ARC DISTANCE OF 837.75 FEET; THENCE NORTH $17^{\circ} 57' 15''$ EAST ALONG A TANGENT LINE 402.57 FEET; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY ALONG A TANGENT CURVE CONCAVE TO THE SOUTHEAST HAVING A RADIUS OF 1,600 FEET A DISTANCE OF ABOUT 880 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO THE MEAN LOW WATER MARK OF THE LEFT BANK OF THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SAID BEING THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE CONTINUING ALONG SAID 1,600 FEET RADIUS CURVE A DISTANCE OF 260 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO THE MEAN LOW WATER MARK OF THE RIGHT BANK OF SAID RIVER, CONTAINING 1.19 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THE PERMIT IS THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT.

APPLICATION FOR BRIDGE RIGHT-OF-WAY ACROSS SUBMERGED LANDS OF SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, NEAR HILLS FERRY, STANISLAUS AND MERCED COUNTIES, STANISLAUS COUNTY - W.O. 3507.

An application has been received from Stanislaus County, on its own behalf and that of Merced County, for a bridge right-of-way 200 feet in width across the San Joaquin River immediately south of its confluence with the Merced River. The bridge, when constructed, will serve the Hills Ferry-Newman Road. No fees or rental are required.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO GRANT TO STANISLAUS AND MERCED COUNTIES A 49-YEAR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR AN AREA 200 FEET IN WIDTH ACROSS THE SUBMERGED LANDS OF THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SITUATE IN STANISLAUS AND MERCED COUNTIES, FOR A BRIDGE RIGHT-OF-WAY.
