

MINUTE ITEM

5. APPLICATION FOR SEWER OUTFALL EASEMENT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF PACIFIC OCEAN ADJOINING CITY OF PACIFICA (SHARP PARK AREA), SAN MATEO COUNTY, CITY OF PACIFICA - W.O. 3680, P.R.C. 2633.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 11 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE CITY OF PACIFICA A 49-YEAR RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT FOR A SEWER OUTFALL LINE ACROSS TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF SAN MATEO COUNTY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A STRIP OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN THE PACIFIC OCEAN ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF PACIFICA, SAN MATEO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SAID STRIP OF LAND BEING FIFTEEN (15) FEET IN WIDTH AND LYING SEVEN AND ONE-HALF (7.5) FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTERLINE:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE, DISTANT THEREON N. 57° 55' E., 194.35 FEET FROM AN IRON PIPE MONUMENT SET AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 38 IN BLOCK 1, AS SAID LOT AND BLOCK ARE SHOWN UPON THAT CERTAIN MAP ENTITLED, "SUBDIVISION NO. 2 OF BRIGHTON BEACH, SAN MATEO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA", WHICH MAP WAS FILED FOR RECORD ON MARCH 18, 1908, IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, IN BOOK 6 OF MAPS AT PAGE 4; THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING S. 88° 47' W., 131 FEET TO ANGLE POINT IN SAID CENTERLINE; THENCE WEST, 123<sup>4</sup> FEET TO THE END OF THE CENTERLINE OF SAID STRIP OF LAND, CONTAINING 0.876 ACRE, MORE OR LESS.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR ISSUANCE OF THE EASEMENT IS THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT.

APPLICATION FOR SEWER OUTFALL EASEMENT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF PACIFIC OCEAN ADJOINING CITY OF PACIFICA (SHARP PARK AREA), SAN MATEO COUNTY, CITY OF PACIFICA - W.O. 3680.

An application has been received from the City of Pacifica for a right-of-way easement for a sewer outfall line 15 feet in width and 2,544 feet in length, containing 0.876 acre, more or less, extending into the Pacific Ocean from the mean high tide line, to serve the City's Sharp Park area. Connecting easements across the upland to the treatment plant have been obtained. The U. S. Public Health Service is furnishing a construction grant for this project.

No fees or charges are required.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE CITY OF PACIFICA A 49-YEAR RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT FOR A SEWER OUTFALL LINE ACROSS TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF SAN MATEO COUNTY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A STRIP OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN THE PACIFIC OCEAN ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF PACIFICA, SAN MATEO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SAID STRIP OF LAND BEING FIFTEEN (15) FEET IN WIDTH AND LYING SEVEN AND ONE-HALF (7.5) FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTER-LINE:

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THE CONSIDERATION FOR ISSUANCE OF THE EASEMENT IS TO BE THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT.
