

MINUTE ITEM

25. SELECTION OF VACANT FEDERAL LAND, LIEU LAND APPLICATION NO. 4988, SACRAMENTO LAND DISTRICT, MENDOCINO COUNTY, FRANK P. DONAHUE - S.W.O. 5741.

After consideration of Calendar Item 8 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINES THAT IT IS TO THE ADVANTAGE OF THE STATE TO SELECT THE FEDERAL LAND EMBRACED IN THE SW $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SW $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 29, T. 13 N., R. 15 W., M.D.M., CONTAINING 40 ACRES IN MENDOCINO COUNTY; AND
2. APPROVES THE SELECTION OF SAID LAND.

SELECTION OF VACANT FEDERAL LAND, LIEU LAND APPLICATION NO. 4988, SACRAMENTO LAND DISTRICT, MENDOCINO COUNTY, FRANK P. DONAHUE - S.W.O. 5741.

An offer was received from Frank P. Donahue of Port Angeles, Washington, to purchase the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, T. 13 N., R. 15 W., M.D.M., containing 40 acres in Mendocino County. This land may be obtained by the State from the Federal Government under the indemnity selection procedure. The applicant made an offer of \$200, or \$5 per acre.

The applicant did not wish to proceed with acquisition of the land, and his application was canceled at his request.

The selection of the subject land is considered to be to the advantage of the State in that it will decrease existing deficiencies in the amounts of school land granted to the State.

The State's application to select the land has been accepted by the Bureau of Land Management and the land was listed (conveyed) to the State on August 30, 1960.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:
