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APPLICATION FOR CCMPENGATORY ROYALTY AGREEAENT, GRIZZLY TSLANVD WATERTOWL MANAGEMENT AREA, SOLANO COUNTY; R. E. RAPF AND EDWARD I. PERRY - W.0. 4196.

An application has been received fron R. E. Rapp and Edward T. Perry to enter into an oil and gas Lease covering an area of approximetely 2589 acres of State land included in the Grizzly Island Waterfowl Mamagenent Area, Solano County.

The land included in the application is under the jurisdiction of the Department of Fish and Gane, and is a portion of approximately 8,58. L acres acquired by the State through a condemation action in 1950 for use as a waterfowl refuge. The judgment, of condemnation reserved to the defendarits an undivided one-half interest in the mineral rights and sperifically provided for the right of the defendents to enter and do all things necessary to remove the minerals so reserved.

At the time of condemnation, the property was included in an oll and gas iease; however, the area applied for was quitclaimed in 1950. The Department ors Fish and Game has specified onerating conditions that would be cesirable in this particular game refuge.

The conditions specified by the Department of Fish and Gane are acceptable to the applicents, and are to be incorporated in the agreement with the Syate.

The applicants have submitted photocopies of an oil and gas lease enterea into with the five current omers of the undivided mineral interest retained by the defendant in the condernation action.

In the opinion of the staff, it is in the best interests of che State to negotiate by agreement fior the development of its mineral interest -

1. In order that the Land may be used for the primary purpose for whiok it was acquired, a waterforl refuge;
2. So as to secure the cperating conditions specified by the Department of Fish and Game;
and, adaditionally, because:
3. The mineral interests in the property are held fifty percent by the State and fifty percent by the five State cotenants.
4. The land incluaded in the proposed compensatory agreement is not within the geologic atructure of any producing oil or gas field.

The office of the Attorney General has advised that a compensatory agreement under the provisions of Section 6815 of the Fublic Resources Code may be considered to be applicable in this instance, and that legally this would appear to be the most desirable method of providing for the development of
the State's interest in the Grizzly Jsiand Waterfowl Management area, (Existing statutes are not prohibitive nor do they make specific provision for the peculiarities of cotenancy problems herewith presented.)

In view of the foregoing, it is proposed to enter into a compensatory agreement with the appiicants which will provide ecr:

1. Royelty: $8-1 / 3 \%$ on all oil, gas, end gas products. (Nomally the State receives $16-2 / 3 \%$. In this instance, the state, holding an undivided $50 \%$ of the mineral rights, is entitled to only one-halif of tre normal royalty rate.)
2. Terms and Conditions:
(a) The egreement is to run coextensively with the leases entered into with the State's cotenants; i.e., for a term or three years and for so long thereafter as oil or gas is produced or drilling operatioris are conducted;
(b) A cash bonus is to be paid to the State of $\$ 1.50$ per acre for entering into the agreement;
(c) Comnencing with the second year and each year thereaftex, if the ayp.licant has not commenced drilling operations or terminated the bereement, an advance rental is to be paid to the State of $\$ 1.50$ per acre;
(d) If the applicant has not comaenced drilling operations within three years, the agreement will terninate.

The applicants bave estialished their qualifications to enter into an agesment with the State. se statutory $\$ 5$ filing fee has been paid.
