24. APPROVAL OF MAPS OF A SURVEY OF THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ALONG THE SHORE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL IN THE VICINITY OF VENTURA, VENTURA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA - W.O. 4203, GEO.-VENTURA CO.

APPROVAL OF MAPS OF A SURVEY OF THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ALONG THE SHORE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL IN THE VICINITY OF VENTURA, VENTURA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA - W.O. 4203.

A field survey was made in 1961 to obtain a permanent record of the location of the Mean High Tide Line prior to construction of a harbor by the Ventura Port District. The breakwaters and jetties, which are part of this harbor development, will create an artificial condition. The mean high tide line will no longer fluctuate naturally, thus fixing the ocean boundary along the last natural position of the shoreline prior to artificial influences.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE AND HAVE RECORDED SHEETS 1 THROUGH 5 OF 5 OF MAPS ENTITLED "SURVEY OF THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ALONG THE SHORE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL, VICINITY OF VENTURA, VENTURA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA", DATED JUNE 1963.
