33. APPROVAL OF PLATS OF THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK ALONG THE SHORE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL IN THE VICINITY OF PORT HUENEME, VENTURA COUNTY - W.O. 3077, GEO.-VENTURA CO.

APPROVAL OF PLATS OF THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK ALONG THE SHORE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL IN THE VICINITY OF PORT HUENEME, VENTURA COUNTY - W.O. 3077.

In 1959, the U. S. Corps of Engineers awarded contracts for the construction of two stone entrance jetties and an offshore breakwater as appurtenant structures to a proposed small craft harbor to be dredged at Hollywood-by-the-Sea.

Shoreline conditions were artificially affected in this area when the Port Hueneme harbor jetties were built in 1939, and it was necessary to survey the mean high tide line prior to the new construction in order to study the effect of the 1939 construction before the adjusted shoreline was again altered by the proposed breakwater.

Subject maps, consisting of 10 sheets, show the Ordinary High Water Mark of 1939, which represents the permanent boundary of State tide and submerged land in this vicinity.
