

MINUTE ITEM

13. APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 75,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL IN THE VICINITY OF THE SHELL OIL COMPANY WHARF IN CARQUINEZ STRAIT AT MARTINEZ, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY; SHELL OIL COMPANY - W.O. 5017, P.R.C. 3153.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 33 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO SHELL OIL COMPANY A PERMIT TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 75,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM THE BED OF CARQUINEZ STRAIT, IN THE VICINITY OF THE SHELL OIL WHARF AT MARTINEZ, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, AT A CHARGE OF \$0.03 PER CUBIC YARD, FOR SPOILS DEPOSITION ON PRIVATELY OWNED LANDS.

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 75,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL IN THE VICINITY OF THE SHELL OIL COMPANY WHARF IN CARQUINEZ STRAIT AT MARTINEZ, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY; SHELL OIL COMPANY - W.O. 5017.

An application has been received from Shell Oil Company for a permit to dredge approximately 75,000 cubic yards of material in the vicinity of its wharf at Martinez, Contra Costa County, in order to maintain navigability fronting the wharf area (see Exhibit "A"). The spoils will be conveyed, via a dredge pipe line, to a spoils area on privately owned lands of the Utah Construction Company (W.O. 5072). The material that it is proposed to dredge is considered poor quality fill, and has been appraised as "Bay Mud" that would bring only the minimum royalty of \$0.03 per cubic yard. The dredging is for the improvement of commerce and navigation.

This Division has apprised the Department of Fish and Game and Water Pollution Control Board No. 2 of the proposed dredging. Shell Oil Company has transmitted a copy of "Letter of Permission" from the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers authorizing the dredging.

The \$5 filing fee has been paid by the applicant.
