30. APPROVAL OF MAPS OF SURVEY OF MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ALONG SHORE OF THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA, VICINITY OF DANA COVE, ORANGE COUNTY - W.O. 4769, GEO.-ORANGE CO.

APPROVAL OF MAPS OF SURVEY OF MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ALONG SHORE OF THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA, VICINITY OF DANA COVE, ORANGE COUNTY - W.O. 4769.

The U.S. Corps of Engineers constructed a groin offshore from Doheny Beach State Park in April and May, 1964, and built up the beach with sand fill to restore an eroded beach and to prevent future erosion. Prior to this construction and fill, the State Lands Division surveyed the Mean High Tide Line to establish the base for location of a portion of the permanent Ordinary High Water Mark. The attached maps delineate the Mean High Tide Line of 1964 through the portion of beach that will be artificially affected by the groin (see Exhibit "A").
