

MINUTE ITEM

4. APPLICATION FOR 49-YEAR EASEMENT, STATE SCHOOL LANDS, PLACER COUNTY;
STATE DIVISION OF FORESTRY - W.O. 4935, P.R.C. 3189.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 19 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A 49-YEAR EASEMENT TO THE STATE DIVISION OF FORESTRY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A FIREBREAK ON THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED PARCEL OF LAND:

A STRIP OF LAND 200 FEET WIDE SITUATE IN THE NW $\frac{1}{4}$ OF THE SE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 16, LOT 2, T. 15 N., R. 10 E., M.D.M., PLACER COUNTY; BEING 100 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTERLINE:

BEGINNING AT A POINT WHICH BEARS S. 13° 30' E. 2,770 FEET MORE OR LESS FROM NW $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER OF SECTION 16; THENCE S. 28° 45' E. 400 FEET MORE OR LESS; CONTAINING 1.84 ACRES.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR ISSUANCE OF THE PERMIT IS TO BE THE PUBLIC BENEFIT.

APPLICATION FOR 49-YEAR EASEMENT, STATE SCHOOL LANDS, PLACER COUNTY; STATE DIVISION OF FORESTRY - W.O. 4935.

The State Division of Forestry has applied for a 49-year easement covering 1.84 acres of State school lands in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, T. 15 N., R. 10 E., M.D.M., for the construction and maintenance of a firebreak (see Exhibit "A").

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A 49-YEAR EASEMENT TO THE STATE DIVISION OF FORESTRY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A FIREBREAK ON THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED PARCEL OF LAND:
