

MINUTE ITEM

36. LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE HEARING ON PUBLIC LANDS OF THE STATE; SENATE FACT FINDING COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES, FRED S. FARR, CHAIRMAN - W.O. 4550.11.

LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE HEARING ON PUBLIC LANDS OF THE STATE; SENATE FACT FINDING COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES, FRED S. FARR, CHAIRMAN - W.O. 4550.11.

The Senate Fact Finding Committee on Natural Resources has scheduled a hearing to be held on September 25, 1964, relative to the current and projected uses of publicly-owned lands in California. The Committee, in a letter dated August 25, 1964, and addressed to Hale Champion, Chairman of the Commission, has requested that the Chairman or his designee appear before the Committee to testify regarding the public lands of the State under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission. (Cf. Exhibit "A".) Pursuant to this request a draft report has been prepared by the staff for presentation to the Committee and is attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO REPORT TO THE SENATE FACT FINDING COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES AT THE HEARING TO BE HELD ON SEPTEMBER 25, 1964.
