

MINUTE ITEM

3. APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO STORE ROCK, SUBMERGED LANDS, SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY; DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME - W.O. 5260, P.R.C. 3214.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 36 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME A 10-YEAR PERMIT TO STORE ROCK ON A PARCEL OF SUBMERGED LAND IN THE BED OF THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, THE SITE BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A PARCEL OF LAND IN THE BED OF THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER NEAR THE HEAD OF THE OLD RIVER ABOUT 3 MILES NORTH OF MOSSDALE, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

ALL LAND BELOW THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE LEFT BANK OF THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER WITHIN A CIRCLE HAVING A DIAMETER OF 260 FEET WITH A CENTER POINT HAVING APPROXIMATE CALIFORNIA ZONE 3 COORDINATES OF X = 1,761,200 Y = 477,630, SAID PARCEL CONTAINING 0.69 ACRE MORE OR LESS.

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO STORE ROCK, SUBMERGED LANDS, SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY; DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME - W.O. 5260.

The State Department of Fish and Game has applied for a permit to use intermittently, during the next 10 years, a 0.69-acre area in the bed of the San Joaquin River below -7.0 feet (U.S.G.S. Datum) for rock storage (see Exhibit "A").

The rock-storage area would be used in conjunction with the closure of Old River, within the boundaries of the El Pescadero Grant. The closure is designed to modify the flow of the San Joaquin River to facilitate salmon migration, and possibly to diminish erosion during high-water periods. When the closure is not necessary, the rock would be stored in the Permit Area. The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers has issued a permit for the project. The upland owner has granted the necessary permission to the Department of Fish and Game.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME A 10-YEAR PERMIT TO STORE ROCK ON A PARCEL OF SUBMERGED LAND IN THE BED OF THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, THE SITE BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

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
