40. CONTROL OF SURFACE FACILITIES BY CITIES AND COUNTIES - W.O. 6000,
GEN. DATA-OIL AND GAS.

Mr. Sieroty introduced the problem of the need for ordinances relating to oil development in other cities and counties of the State similar to those in force in the City of Los Angeles, suggesting that, although the State had no direct power in this regard, it should bring the matter to the attention of all cities and counties. Commissioner Champion indicated that such recommendations were more properly a matter for legislative action.

It was informally agreed that a letter containing a copy of the subject ordinance of the City of Los Angeles should be sent by the Commission's staff to the League of California Cities and to the County Supervisors' Association, with the request that they make further distribution.
