

MINUTE ITEM

14. APPLICATION FOR ASSIGNMENT OF PROSPECTING PERMIT P.R.C. 3064.2, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY; HOWARD HUNT AND ADAM NATALIE - W.O. 5399.

After consideration of Calendar Item 3 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE THE ASSIGNMENT OF PROSPECTING PERMIT P.R.C. 3064.2 FROM HOWARD HUNT AND ADAM J. NATALIE TO ADAM J. NATALIE, WITH THE ASSIGNEE TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS OF THE PROSPECTING PERMIT TO THE SAME EXTENT AS THE ORIGINAL PERMITTEES.

APPLICATION FOR ASSIGNMENT OF PROSPECTING PERMIT P.R.C. 3064.2, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY; HOWARD HUNT AND ADAM NATALIE - W.O. 5399.

Prospecting Permit P.R.C. 3064.2 was issued to Howard Hunt and Adam Natalie on November 6, 1963, for a period of two years.

Adam Natalie states that Howard Hunt, his partner, has disappeared and left no forwarding address; however, the Division file on this matter contains a quitclaim deed executed by Howard Hunt by which he conveys his interest in the prospecting permit to Adam J. Natalie.

An application has been received from Adam Natalie, requesting approval of an assignment of Prospecting Permit 3064.2 to Adam Natalie, an individual.

Section 21 of the permit requires that the permittee shall not assign or sublet the prospecting permit or any right or rights thereunder without first obtaining the written consent of the Commission thereto.

A form of assignment has been executed by Adam Natalie for Howard Hunt and Adam J. Natalie and accepted by Adam J. Natalie.

The \$5 statutory filing fee has been paid by the applicant. The permittee has completed the number of shifts and submitted the reports required by the permit.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO APPROVE THE ASSIGNMENT OF PROSPECTING PERMIT P.R.C. 3064.2 FROM HOWARD HUNT AND ADAM J. NATALIE TO ADAM J. NATALIE, WITH THE ASSIGNEE TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS OF THE PROSPECTING PERMIT TO THE SAME EXTENT AS THE ORIGINAL PERMITTEES.
