

MINUTE ITEM

16. APPLICATION FOR NONCOMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY; GEORGE SPECKMAN - W.O. 5357, P.R.C. 3269.1

After consideration of Calendar Item 11 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO GEORGE SPECKMAN A FIVE-YEAR NONCOMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, AT A TOTAL RENTAL OF \$25, FOR THE LOCATION OF A PICNIC TABLE AND FACILITIES ON LANDS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A PARCEL OF LAND IN THE ABANDONED CHANNEL OF THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER BETWEEN VULCAN ISLAND AND ROBERTS ISLAND, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE BOUNDARY LINE OF VULCAN ISLAND, AS SAID ISLAND WAS CONVEYED BY DEED DATED JUNE 4, 1956, FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA TO GEORGE SPECKMAN, WHICH BEARS S. 36° 38' 23" W. 1150.24 FEET AND N. 64° 56' W. 8.00 FEET FROM U.S.E.D. MONUMENT NO. 150 D.W.; THENCE PROCEEDING ALONG SAID BOUNDARY N. 67° 08' E. 93.00 FEET AND N. 75° 20' E. 118.81 FEET TO THE SOUTHERLY LINE OF THE STOCKTON DEEP WATER CHANNEL; THENCE ALONG SAID CHANNEL LINE S. 64° 56' E. 237.56 FEET; THENCE LEAVING SAID LINE S. 77° 18' W. 461.34 FEET AND N. 12° 42' W. 125.00 FEET TO THE ABOVEMENTIONED BOUNDARY LINE OF VULCAN ISLAND; THENCE ALONG SAID LINE N. 77° 18' E. 63.27 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; CONTAINING 1.166 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

APPLICATION FOR NONCOMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY; GEORGE SPECKMAN - W.O. 5357.

George Speckman, owner of Vulcan Island, has made application to the State Lands Commission for a noncommercial minor-structure permit on 1.166 acres of tide and submerged land in the abandoned channel of the San Joaquin River, adjacent to Vulcan Island, San Joaquin County.

Mr. Speckman has stated that the parcel would be used only for private recreational purposes, including partial clearing of the brush and the erection of a picnic table and facilities.

The character of the land is such that a Department of the Army navigation permit is not required.

Mr. Speckman has paid the \$5 filing fee and the \$25 permit fee.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO GEORGE SPECKMAN A FIVE-YEAR NONCOMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, AT A TOTAL RENTAL OF \$25, FOR THE LOCATION OF A PICNIC TABLE AND FACILITIES ON LANDS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A PARCEL OF LAND IN THE ABANDONED CHANNEL OF THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER BETWEEN VULCAN ISLAND AND ROBERTS ISLAND, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE BOUNDARY LINE OF VULCAN ISLAND, AS SAID ISLAND WAS CONVEYED BY DEED DATED JUNE 4, 1956, FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA TO GEORGE SPECKMAN, WHICH BEARS S. 36° 38' 23" W. 1150.24 FEET AND N. 64° 56' W. 8.00 FEET FROM U.S.E.D. MONUMENT NO. 150 D.W.; THENCE PROCEEDING ALONG SAID BOUNDARY N. 67° 08' E. 93.00 FEET AND N. 75° 20' E. 118.81 FEET TO THE SOUTHERLY LINE OF THE STOCKTON DEEP WATER CHANNEL; THENCE ALONG SAID CHANNEL LINE S. 64° 56' E. 237.56 FEET; THENCE LEAVING SAID LINE S. 77° 18' W. 461.34 FEET AND N. 12° 42' W. 125.00 FEET TO THE ABOVEMENTIONED BOUNDARY LINE OF VULCAN ISLAND; THENCE ALONG SAID LINE N. 77° 18' E. 63.27 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; CONTAINING 1.166 ACRES MORE OR LESS.
