15. APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO CONDUCT SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL OPERATIONS; SANTA BARBARA, VENTURA, LOS ANGELES, ORANGE AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES; CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY - W.O. 5670, P.R.C. 3325.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 11 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY A GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT, CONFORMING TO ALL OPERATING CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION FOR THE CONDUCT OF GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION OPERATIONS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT CONCEPTION, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, EXCEPT THE FOLLOWING:

1. LANDS INCLUDED IN SECTION 6871.2(b) OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE;
2. LANDS LYING ADJACENT TO THE MAINLAND BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE NORTH-WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND A LINE FORMING THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF ORANGE COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF.

THE PERMIT IS TO BE ISSUED FOR A SIX-MONTH PERIOD FROM JUNE 28, 1965, THROUGH DECEMBER 27, 1965.

THE PERMITTEE IS TO REIMBURSE THE STATE LANDS DIVISION FOR ALL OF ITS INSPECTION COSTS. THE PERMIT IS TO BE EFFECTIVE ONLY AS LONG AS A CONCURRENT PERMIT BY THE FISH AND GAME COMMISSION IS IN EFFECT FOR THE SAME OPERATING AREA.

An application has been received from Continental Oil Company for a permit to conduct geophysical operations in the area between Point Conception and the Mexican Border.

The Boards of Supervisors of the counties of Santa Barbara, Ventura, Los Angeles, Orange, and San Diego and the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Santa Barbara have been informed that this application is to be considered. Continental Oil Company also has submitted an application to the Department of Fish and Game for the conduct of seismic operations in the above-described area.

The statutory filing fee has been paid by the applicant.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY A GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT, CONFORMING TO ALL OPERATING CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION FOR THE CONDUCT OF GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION OPERATIONS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT CONCEPTION, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, EXCEPT THE FOLLOWING:
