38. APPROVAL OF MAP OF GRANT TO UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (NAVY), VICINITY OF MARE ISLAND, SOLANO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA - W.O. 5655, GEO. -SOLANO CO.

After consideration of Calendar Item 16 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE AND HAVE RECORDED SHEET 1 OF 1 OF MAP ENTITLED "MAP OF GRANT TO UNITED STATES (NAVY), CHAPTER 1452, STATUTES OF 1963, VICINITY OF MARE ISLAND" SOLANO COUNTY, DATED MAY 1965.

APPROVAL OF MAP OF GRANT TO UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (NAVY), VICINITY OF MARE ISLAND, SOLANO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA - W.O. 5655.

The Statutes of 1897 granted to the United States, for military purposes, a strip of tide and submerged land between the high water mark and 300 yards beyond the low water mark, adjacent to lands of the United States.

Chapter 1452 of the Statutes of 1963 specifically described the granted area in the vicinity of Mare Island, and the line "300 yards beyond the low water mark" in particular. The purpose of that legislation was to clarify the position of the line inasmuch as it is also the landward line of a grant to Vallejo, Chapter 1501 of the Statutes of 1957. The grant to Vallejo was mapped subsequent to the passage of the 1963 act.

At the time of the mapping of the grant to Vallejo, the Navy did not desire a separate grant map since the area granted to the Navy was also shown on the Vallejo grant map. Recently, however, the Navy requested a separate map of its grant as described in Chapter 1452 of the Statutes of 1963.

Minor changes in the map of the grant to Vallejo have been made to conform this map to a map of the grant to United States (Navy) (Exhibit "A" attached).
