

3. APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF LOCATION OF SUBMERGED COMMUNICATIONS CABLE ACROSS PIPER SLOUGH IN CONTRA COSTA COUNTY; THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY - W.O. 5713, P.R.C. 3330.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 11 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 7901 OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE AND OF ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OPINION NO. 52/56, IN THE FORM PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION, APPROVING THE LOCATION OF A SUBMERGED COMMUNICATIONS CABLE ACROSS UNGRANTED TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF PIPER SLOUGH, IN THE VICINITY OF FRANKS TRACT, AS SHOWN ON MAP FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS DIVISION.

APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF LOCATION OF SUBMERGED COMMUNICATIONS CABLE ACROSS PIPER SLOUGH IN CONTRA COSTA COUNTY; THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY - W.O. 5713.

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has applied for approval of the location of a submerged communications cable crossing ungranted tide and submerged lands of Piper Slough, approximately 1,000 feet northeasterly of Bethel Island Road, Contra Costa County. (The general vicinity is shown on Exhibit "A".) The proposed crossing is about 307 feet long and 40 feet wide.

The Commission previously adopted an "Approval-of-Location Agreement Form" to be used for telephone and telegraph facilities crossing State lands, in accordance with Section 7901 of the Public Utilities Code and with Attorney General's Opinion No. 52/56.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 7901 OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE AND OF ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OPINION NO. 52/56, IN THE FORM PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION, APPROVING THE LOCATION OF A SUBMERGED COMMUNICATIONS CABLE ACROSS UNGRANTED TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF PIPER SLOUGH, IN THE VICINITY OF FRANKS TRACT, AS SHOWN ON MAP FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS DIVISION.
