19. APPLICATION FOR A COMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT TO ANCHOR TWO MOORING BUOYS ON SOVEREIGN LAND OF LAKE TAHOE IN EL DORADO COUNTY; JAMES AND BARBARA TALMADGE - W.O. 5149, P.R.C. 3356.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 15 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO JAMES AND BARBARA TALMADGE A FIVE-YEAR COMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, IN CONSIDERATION OF A TOTAL RENT OF \$50, FOR THE LOCATION OF TWO MOORING BUOYS ON SUBMERGED LAND OF LAKE TAHOE DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

TWO CIRCULAR PARCELS OF SUBMERGED LAND 10 FEET IN DIAMETER IN LAKE TAHOE, EL DORADO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA; THEIR CENTERPOINTS BEING LOCATED 10 FEET SOUTHERLY OF THE COMMON BOUNDARY BETWEEN PLACER AND EL DORADO COUNTIES, AND 150 AND 210 FEET, RESPECTIVELY, EASTERLY OF THE ORDINARY LOW WATER MARK OF LAKE TAHOE, CONTAINING 0.0036 ACRE MORE OR LESS.

APPLICATION FOR A COMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT TO ANCHOR TWO MOORING BUOYS ON SOVEREIGN LAND OF LAKE TAHOE IN EL DORADO COUNTY; JAMES AND BARBARA TALMADGE - W.O. 5149.

Mr. and Mrs. James Talmadge, d.b.a. Stanola Lodge, at Tahoe, have applied for a permit to anchor two small boat mooring buoys on State land of Lake Tahoe in El Dorado County, as shown on Exhibit "A".

The buoys are to be 12" in diameter, of styrofoam construction, and marked according to the California Waterway Marker System. The Corps of Engineers has approved location of the buoys.

The permit is to be for a term of five years. The total rent of \$50 has been paid.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO JAMES AND BARBARA TALMADGE A FIVE-YEAR COMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, IN CONSIDERATION OF A TOTAL RENT OF \$50, FOR THE LOCATION OF TWO MOORING BUOYS ON SUBMERGED LAND OF LAKE TAHOE, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:
