6. APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO ANCHOR DRILL BARGES AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY, SAN MATEO COUNTY; STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF BAY TOLL CROSSINGS - W.O. 5821, P.R.C. 3373.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 19 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF BAY TOLL CROSSINGS, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT, A PERMIT TO ANCHOR DRILL BARGES AS NECESSARY TO PERFORM SOIL TEST BORINGS IN THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF SAN FRANCISCO BAY:

SIERRA POINT CROSSING

A STRIP OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND 4,000 FEET WIDE ACROSS SAN FRANCISCO BAY, SAN MATEO COUNTY, BEING 2000 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF A LINE DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN SAN MATEO AND ALAMEDA COUNTIES WHICH HAS APPROXIMATE CALIFORNIA ZONE 3 COORDINATES OF $X = 1,491,178.95$, $Y = 434,547.58$, THENCE N. $82^{\circ} 00' 00''$ W. ACROSS THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY 40,000 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE MEAN LOW TIDE LINE OF SAN FRANCISCO BAY; CONTAINING 3,673 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

BEARINGS AND DISTANCES USED IN THE ABOVE DESCRIPTION ARE BASED ON THE CALIFORNIA COORDINATE SYSTEM ZONE 3.

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO ANCHOR DRILL BARGES AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY, SAN MATEO COUNTY; STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF BAY TOLL CROSSINGS - W.O. 5821.

The Division of Bay Toll Crossings, Department of Public Works, has applied for a permit to anchor drill barges at various locations along proposed crossings of San Francisco Bay, as shown on Exhibit "A".

The barges will be used to perform soil test borings preliminary to bridge construction. The permit would terminate on December 31, 1965.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF BAY TOLL CROSSINGS, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT, A PERMIT TO ANCHOR DRILL BARGES AS NECESSARY TO PERFORM SOIL TEST BORINGS IN THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF SAN FRANCISCO BAY:

SIERRA POINT CROSSING

A STRIP OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND 4000 FEET WIDE ACROSS SAN FRANCISCO BAY, SAN MATEO COUNTY, BEING 2000 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF A LINE DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN SAN MATEO AND ALAMEDA COUNTIES WHICH HAS APPROXIMATE CALIFORNIA ZONE 3 COORDINATES OF X=1,491,178.95 Y=434,547.58, THENCE N. 82° 00' 00" W. ACROSS THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY 40,000 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE MEAN LOW TIDE LINE OF SAN FRANCISCO BAY; CONTAINING 3,673 ACRES MORE OR LESS.
