

4. APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY DETOUR EASEMENT OVER STATE SOVEREIGN LAND IN VICINITY OF ANAHEIM BAY AT NAVAL WEAPONS STATION, SEAL BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY; STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS - W.O. 5609, P.R.C. 3419.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 3 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 101.5 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE, FOR RESERVATION FOR A DETOUR RIGHT-OF-WAY OVER A PARCEL OF STATE SOVEREIGN LAND IN THE VICINITY OF ANAHEIM BAY AT SEAL BEACH IN ORANGE COUNTY, AS SHOWN ON HIGHWAY MAP 07-04-1-31.3/32.1.

APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY DETOUR EASEMENT OVER STATE SOVEREIGN LAND IN VICINITY OF ANAHEIM BAY AT NAVAL WEAPONS STATION, SEAL BEACH ORANGE COUNTY; STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS - W.O. 5609.

The Division of Highways has submitted an application, pursuant to Section 101.5 of the Streets and Highways Code, for a temporary right-of-way over a 100-foot strip of sovereign land in the waterway inlet from Anaheim Bay into Sunset Bay, in T. 5 S., R. 12 W., S.B.M., at the U. S. Naval Weapons Station, Seal Beach, Orange County, as shown on Map 07-ORA-1-31.3/32.1 (see Exhibit "A" attached).

The easement is required for detour purposes during construction of a permanent replacement bridge on existing Route 1.
