

10. APPLICATION FOR RECREATIONAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN GULF OF SANTA CATALINA, ORANGE COUNTY; W. I. CAIN - W.O. 5749, P.R.C. 3438.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 27 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO W. I. CAIN, FOR THE FEE OF \$25, A FIVE-YEAR RECREATIONAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PIER ON THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED LAND:

A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND 10.00 FEET WIDE IN THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA, ORANGE COUNTY, APPROXIMATELY 3 MILES NORTHWEST OF DANA POINT, LYING 5 FEET ON EITHER SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTERLINE:

COMMENCING AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 5, TRACT 728, AS SHOWN ON A MAP FILED IN BOOK 25, PAGE 20 OF MISCELLANEOUS MAPS, RECORDS OF ORANGE COUNTY; THENCE ALONG THE SOUTHERLY LINE OF LOT 5 N. 88° 48' 00" W. 234.18 FEET, TO A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA; THENCE NORTHERLY ALONG SAID MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE N. 14° 44' 53" W., 13.05 FEET, N. 11° 37' 05" E., 61.34 FEET, AND N. 15° 47' 21" W., 22.30 FEET TO THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THIS DESCRIPTION; THENCE S. 48° 44' 20" W., 25.00 FEET; CONTAINING 0.006 ACRE MORE OR LESS.

APPLICATION FOR RECREATIONAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN GULF OF SANTA CATALINA, ORANGE COUNTY; W. I. CAIN - W.O. 5749.

Mr. W. I. Cain, owner of the adjacent upland, has applied for a recreational minor-structure permit to construct a 10' x 24' pier on a 0.006-acre parcel of tide and submerged land adjacent to 32223 Coast Highway, South Laguna, California, as shown on Exhibit "A".

The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers issued a navigational permit to Mr. Cain on April 5, 1965.

A fee of \$25 will be charged for a five-year term.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO W. I. CAIN, FOR THE FEE OF \$25, A FIVE-YEAR RECREATIONAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PIER ON THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED LAND:

A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND 10.00 FEET WIDE IN THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA, ORANGE COUNTY, APPROXIMATELY 3 MILES NORTHWEST OF DANA POINT, LYING 5 FEET ON EITHER SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTERLINE:

COMMENCING AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 5, TRACT 728, AS SHOWN ON A MAP FILED IN BOOK 25, PAGE 20 OF MISCELLANEOUS MAPS, RECORDS OF ORANGE COUNTY; THENCE ALONG THE SOUTHERLY LINE OF LOT 5 N. 88° 48' 00" W. 234.18 FEET, TO A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA; THENCE NORTHERLY ALONG SAID MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE N. 14° 44' 53" W., 13.05 FEET, N. 11° 37' 05" E., 61.34 FEET, AND N. 15° 47' 21" W., 22.30 FEET TO THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THIS DESCRIPTION; THENCE S. 48° 44' 20" W., 25.00 FEET; CONTAINING 0.006 ACRE MORE OR LESS.
