13. APPLICATION FOR COMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT TO PLACE TEMPORARY MOORING BUOY ON UNGRANTED SOVEREIGN LAND IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY, SAN MATEO COUNTY; KAISER STEEL CORPORATION - W.O. 5942, P.R.C. 3441.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 19 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO KAISER STEEL CORPORATION A PERMIT TO ANCHOR A STEEL MOORING BUOY DURING THE PERIOD DECEMBER 1, 1965, TO NOVEMBER 30, 1966, FOR THE FEE OF \$50, ON THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED LAND:

A CIRCULAR PARCEL OF SUBMERGED LAND 10 FEET IN DIAMETER, IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY, SAN MATEO COUNTY, APPROXIMATELY THREE MILES NORTHEASTERLY OF SAN MATEO, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

SAID CIRCULAR PARCEL LIES 1500 FEET NORTHWESTERLY AT RIGHT ANGLES FROM THE CENTERLINE OF THE SAN MATEO-HAYWARD BRIDGE, AND 2000 FEET SOUTHEASTERLY (ALONG A LINE PARALLEL TO THE BRIDGE CENTERLINE) FROM THE CENTERLINE OF THE 500-FOOT NAVIGATION CHANNEL, AND CONTAINS .002 ACRE MORE OR LESS.

APPLICATION FOR COMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT TO PLACE TEMPORARY MOORING BUOY ON UNGRANTED SOVEREIGN LAND IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY, SAN MATEO COUNTY; KAISER STEEL CORPORATION- W.O. 5942.

Kaiser Steel Corporation has applied for a permit to anchor a steel mooring buoy on State land in San Francisco Bay (as shown on Exhibit "A"), for use during erection of the San Mateo-Hayward Bridge superstructure from December 1, 1965, to November 30, 1966.

The fee will be \$50.

An application for a U. S. Army Corps of Engineers navigational permit has been processed with concurrence by all State agencies.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO KAISER STEEL CORPORATION A PERMIT TO ANCHOR A STEEL MOORING BUOY DURING THE PERIOD DECEMBER 1, 1965, TO NOVEMBER 30, 1966, FOR THE FEE OF \$50, ON THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED LAND:
