APPLICATION FOR DREDGING PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, BELMONT COVE, SAN MATEO COUNTY; ESTERO MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT - W.O. 6087.

An application has been received from the Estero Municipal District to dredge approximately 1800 cubic yards of material (grayish, salty clay) from a portion of the bed of Belmont Cove, San Mateo County, for the construction of a water intake facility to provide daily fresh bay water circulation through the interior lagoons of Foster City. The material will be deposited in a proposed regional park area situated on State lands described as Parcel "A", under Life-of-Structure Permit P.R.C. 2860.9(B) issued by the State Lands Division to the applicant on March 29, 1962.

Section 6303 of the Public Resources Code provides that the Commission may grant the privilege of depositing material upon, or removing or extracting material from, tide or submerged lands owned by the State for the improvement of navigation or reclamation, upon such terms and conditions and for such consideration as will be for the best interests of the State.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has issued a Department of the Army permit authorizing the conduct of dredging operations at the location described in the application. The Division of Beaches and Parks has reported that issuance of the permit would have no effect upon any program or project of that Department, and that there are no known recreational activities on their land or lands littoral that would be adversely affected. The Department of Fish and Game has reviewed the application and has reported that it believes the project will have negligible effect on fish and wildlife. The Department of Water Resources has reviewed and approved the proposed project.

The \$5 filing fee has been submitted by the applicant.
