8. ASSIGNMENT OF GRAZING LEASE P.R.C. 3065.2, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, WILLIAM I. MOORE TO T. C. ELLSWORTH - S.W.O. 7955.

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE THE ASSIGNMENT OF GRAZING LEASE P.R.C. 3065.2, FROM WILLIAM I. MOORE TO T. C. ELLSWORTH, COVERING 13,830.66 ACRES OF STATE SCHOOL LAND IN SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY.

Grazing Lease P.R.C. 3065.2 was issued on November 6, 1963, to William I. Moore of Sheridan, Wyoming, for the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 16 and Section 36, T. 15 N., R. 9 E.; Section 16, T. 15 N., R. 10 E.; Tract 37, T. 16 N., R. 11 E.; fractional Section 16, T. 16 N., R. 13 E.; Section 16, T. 16 N., R. 14 E.; Sections 16 and 36, T. 17 N., R. 9 E.; Sections 16 and 36, T. 17 N., R. 10 E.; Section 36, T. 17 N., R. 11 E.; Section 36, T. 17 N., R. 12 E.; Section 16, T. 17 N., R. 14 E.; Sections 16 and 36, T. 18 N., R. 9 E.; Sections 16 and 36, T. 18 N., R. 10 E.; Sections 16 and 36, T. 18 N., R. 11 E.; Sections 16 and 36, T. 18 N., R. 12 E.; and Section 36, T. 18 N., R. 13 E., S.B.M., containing a total of 13,830.66 acres in San Bernardino County. Said lease was issued for a period of five years, commencing November 6, 1963, and ending November 5, 1968, at an annual rental of \$207.46.

An appropriate assignment form was executed by William I. Moore and was accepted by the assignee, T. C. Ellsworth on May 9, 1966.

The lease provides that the lessee shall not transfer or assign the lease except upon the prior written consent of the State.

The statutory filing fee of \$5.00 has been paid.
