16. APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TERM OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT P.R.C. 3115.1, ORANGE AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES; STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC.

After consideration of Calendar Item 31 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC., AN EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT P.R.C. 3115.1 FOR THE PERIOD FEBRUARY 16, 1967, THROUGH AUGUST 15, 1967, ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE SOUTH-EASTERLY BOUNDARY OF ORANGE COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA. ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT ARE TO REMAIN UNCHANGED AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TERM OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT P.R.C. 3115.1, ORANGE AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES; STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC.

An application has been received from Standard Oil Company of California, Western Operations, Inc., for an extension of the term of Geological Survey Permit P.R.C. 3115.1 for the period February 16, 1967, through August 15, 1967, in order to continue core-drilling operations. The present permit will expire February 15, 1967.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC., AN EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT P.R.C. 3115.1 FOR THE PERIOD FEBRUARY 16, 1967, THROUGH AUGUST 15, 1967, ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF ORANGE COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.
