APPLICATION FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT OVER STATE LAND IN SACRAMENTO RIVER AT COLUSA, COLUSA COUNTY; PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY - W.O. 6438.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company has requested a 25- x 50-foot easement for the maintenance of an existing overhead 240-volt power line over State land in the Sacramento River one mile east of Colusa (as shown on Exhibit "A").

The line was installed in 1966 to provide power to a privately owned irrigation pump. The company was not aware of its encroachment on State land until so informed by staff.

in appraisal of the land indicates a total rental of \$100 for an initial lease period of 15 years. The lease will provide for three renewal options of 10 years each.
